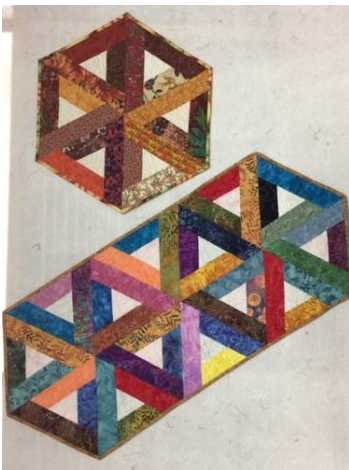

TRIANGLE FRENZY SWIRL TABLE RUNNER

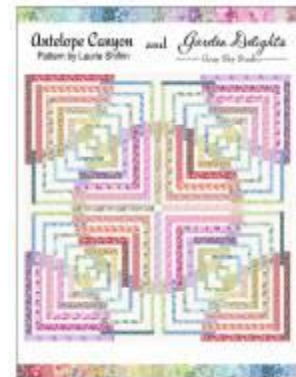
